PREFACE

The publication of the *Index to the Rattler* for 1980 to 2003 was so well received that I have been encouraged to do another volume of the previous twenty years. The following preface is basically the same as that published in the first volume since the methodology followed is the same. A few differences have been noted.

Indexes are, for the most part, self-explanatory. Either the word/subject is there or it isn't. Sometimes, however, the topic may be in the index, but under a different word or name which is why in this index you will find "see" or "see also" for some entries. It's also helpful and important to know what general things have been included, and what has been excluded and how to "read" the index, and I will start with that. The entries are by dates of publication, rather than volume or issue, therefore the citation is month/day/year (last two digits) and page number. If an article continues on another page, usually only the first page indicated. It should be noted that at times the inside pages have the wrong date, usually from the previous issue. The date on the first page is the one that was used. If there is a photo related to the article, the reference is followed by a "p" in parentheses. At times there may be only a photo. An "a" in parentheses after a reference means that it is an article written by the individual.

Along with the topical index there are two others which may prove useful to some people:

- there is an index of speakers who have lectured and whose names have appeared in the *Rattler*, but only if they did so at St. Mary's. There are numerous references to, or announcements and articles about, speakers at other San Antonio institutions. Those who spoke here may have been invited by the University administration, a department or some organization. Most in-house speakers (e.g. faculty members) have not been included. In some instances there is a mention of a speaker but no date is given. That person is not included either. The 1978-79 *Rattler* was especially remiss in noting the dates of events.

- there is also an index of students whose names have appeared in the *Rattler* if there was biographical information about them, a somewhat lengthy article including more than just one aspect of their being at St. Mary's, or if they have done something particularly noteworthy, provided it is related to the university in some way.

While there are a few exceptions, here is a list of things that are *not* found in this index:

- Ads (including those placed by ROTC)
- General articles on San Antonio, entertainment (e.g. movie reviews), or happenings at other universities or institutions, or on a national or local level.
- Editorials, Commentaries, and Letters to the Editor
- Photo or opinion polls or answers to the Question of the Week which appeared in some issues
- Announcements or calendars of events unless they are of an informative nature and not merely reminders, with the exception of dramatic or musical performances since this may be the only reference to them.
- Social events such as luncheons, teas, dances (including the prom and military ball)

A few comments on some things which are included:

- Sports: every issue of the *Rattler* has at least one page dedicated to individual sports. The index cites those articles which give an overall appreciation of the particular sport, or

the team, the general outlook for the coming year or the final results of the year. Individual game results are not included. Team pictures are, whether they are group photos or individual photos. Anyone following the various references would have a kind of history of the sport. Other topics related to sports are found under Athletics.

- Activities in and for the community outside of St. Mary's were frequently organized by fraternities or sororities and can be found under the names of these groups or under community services.

- Housing facilities may appear under "Dorms" or "Residence Halls", depending on the word used in the article. Many are also listed individually by name.

- Individuals listed are mostly faculty and staff members of St. Mary's including personnel of the Law School even though it is separate subtitle within the general index. Some of the entries may refer only to articles written by the individual and these are followed by the "a" in parentheses as indicated above. An individual is not listed every time his or her name appears in an article unless the person has been quoted at some length or there is some biographical information included. Titles (Doctor, Professor) have been omitted, except for religious and military titles (Rev., Bro., Sr. for sister, Cpt.). A new feature in this volume is an entry for "Visitors" who were not invited as speakers.

- All of the topics related to the Law School are found as subtitles under that general title (e.g. Red Mass is not listed with the "r"s, but alphabetically under the Law School).

- In the late 1960's Student Council and Student Government were used interchangeably. Entries are listed according to the use of the term.

Once you have found one or more issues which contain information you are looking for, the articles themselves may be found on microfilm which is located on the first floor of the Louis J. Blume library, where they can also be printed out, or in printed form in the Special Collections area of the library on the third floor. Some non-bound issues can be photocopied.
